**Bootcamp-Obstacle Course- *limit three-member teams per school***

All medals will be awarded on an individual achievement basis  
Repelling, wall climbing, mud-pit, all of the things that you can think of

**Triathlon- *limit one each three-member team per school***

All medals will be awarded on a team achievement basis  
0.5 mile Kayak  
3.1 mile run  
0.5 mile 'push' of an old Harley through an obstacle course in the parking lot of Farrow's

**Golf- Oakhaven- *shotgun start- limit one each four member team per school***

18 hole scramble format- no handicap- lowest team score wins  
Team awards- Medals will be awarded to three lowest foursomes  
Individual awards- three lowest scores among all individuals

**Flag Football, softball-*limit one team per school***

Round robin tournament- two losses and you're out  
Championship game and bronze medal game will occur on Sunday  
Medals awarded on a Team basis

**Track & Field events- *limit two members per event per school***

100 meter, 200 meter and 400 meter dash  
4x400 relay, 4x100 relay, 1 mile run
