All of the above scholarships are available **only** to residents of Central Ohio, which includes Delaware, Fairfield, Franklin, Licking, Madison, Pickaway and Union Counties.

ROTC/JROTC SCHOLARSHIPS

Intent: Awarded annually at the Armed Forces Day Luncheon to freshman and sophomore college students in the ROTC and high school seniors in the JROTC programs.

Criteria: Must be able verify status as an enrolled college student in a ROTC program (freshman or sophomore only) or high school senior in a JROTC program. Additionally, each applicant must submit proof of grade point average of 2.0 or higher and must also submit a 500-word, type-written, double-spaced essay on "Why I want a Higher Education". The essay will be on plain white, 8 ½" by 11" paper. The school counselor or ROTC commander must sign, date, and provide their phone number in the "Remarks" section of the application verifying the student's enrollment status and GPA.

Date due: Application must be received by April 25th.

VETERANS DAY SCHOLARSHIPS

Awarded annually at the City of Columbus' ceremony preceding the annual Veterans Day parade. Recipients will be a guest in the Veterans Day parade.

Intent: To provide scholarship to veterans or their children or grandchildren.

Criteria: Must be able verify status service member (or dependent of service member) status by providing a DD Form 214, Report of Separation, and if applicable, a written explanation of relationship to service member. Additionally, each applicant must submit proof of grade point average of 2.0 or higher. Must submit a 500-word, type-written, double-spaced essay on "Why I want a Higher Education". The essay will be on plain white, 8 ½" by 11" paper. The school counselor must sign, date, and provide their phone number in the "Remarks" section of the application verifying the student's enrollment status and GPA.

Date due: Application must be received by October 25th.

All applications submitted without the appropriate supporting documentation will not be considered. More detailed award guidelines are available upon request.

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
